The centres that have participated in this project have included Mullan Mews, Sydenham Court, and Palmerston, all supported living centres in East Belfast for people living with dementia. There are also some art works produced in Helmsworth Court, with the Play Resource Warehouse, and a piece by the late Harold Turner.

The Festival of Windows is a celebration of the creativity of people living with dementia and it highlights the incredible work of these centres across East Belfast.
