Good advice is a key feature of addressing the impact of dementia. The better informed we are the better quality of life people affected by dementia can have. Throughout May there are a range of dementia information stalls throughout Belfast.

Dementia Action Week - 13th -19th May 2024

Dementia Action Week is back this May. Each year Alzheimer's Society works with individuals and organisations across Northern Ireland to encourage people to act on dementia.

This year communities are being encouraged to Stand Up For Your Loved Ones. Research has highlighted that people affected by dementia are often failed by the social care system, and during the Covid-19 Pandemic people affected by dementia were among the worst hit. The government is being asked to re-build the social care

system in 2024, both nationally and regionally.

During Dementia Action Week there is an extensive number of Dementia Information Stands across Belfast. Further events include Tea Dances, the launch of the Resilient West Belfast Wellbeing App, and the Big Busk for Dementia on Friday 17th May at Corn Market in Belfast between 12-2pm. There's lots on.

Dementia Information Day

Belfast Dementia Information Day is on the way on Wednesday 29th May 2024. The event is taking place in Belfast City Hall between 11am-1pm.

Dementia Information Day is aimed at people affected by dementia, those living with the condition and also family members and carers, to publicise supports that are available in the local community.

The event takes place in the Great Hall at Belfast City Hall, with a smaller quieter room in the Banqueting Suite for people to take "time out". There will be stalls from a number of partners including East Belfast Community Development Agency, Engage with Age, Age NI, Alzheimer's Society, Praxis, Dementia NI, Eastside Greenways, and more. Belfast Trust Dementia Navigators will be there to promote how their service can assist people with a dementia diagnosis.
