Positive Ageing Month


October is Positive Ageing Month in Belfast. Throughout October there is an incredible range of events for older people, including people who are affected by dementia. Positive Ageing Month celebrates the contribution older people make to their communities and the city of Belfast.

The programme of activities includes information sessions for older people about services and opportunities for them, sessions with practical help such as home safety and support for IT, as well as walks, tours and entertainment.

Highlights include the "Be Prepared" event at 2 Royal Avenue, the Age Friendly Convention, virtual and in-person tea dances, and a free screening of "The Quiet Man" movie at Belfast City Hall.

For people affected by dementia there is in-person and online dementia training, art and dementia training for cares and crafters, events for carers, loneliness training, and the "Remember I Forget" exhibition at 2 Royal Avenue throughout the month.
