Your Local Libraries

January can be a dull and difficult month. So we are lucky to have a host of local libraries at our disposal to help dispel the January blues.

Gone are the days of libraries being revered places of hushed reading and learning. These days libraries boast a range of services and activities to support to the communities they serve.

In addition to books, libraries have an extensive range of magazines, CDs and DVDs available for loan. Libraries provide members of the public with free access to computers and the internet, allowing customers to undertake online administration, research and web, and stay up to date.

All libraries offer a range of activities throughout the week. These include tea and newspapers, at which customers can get a cuppa and browse the newspapers, knit and natter sessions, and "Rhyme Time" for children, parents and grandparents. Other sessions include film clubs, and specialist sessions such as regular game playing and chess clubs.

One of the most regular and popular library events in East Belfast is the monthly performance by Tullycarnet Yarnspinners, who routinely perform at Tullycarnet Library every month. Their story telling sessions bring tales and yarns presented by professional story tellers, and also offer opportunities for new story telling talent to share their stories.

The Carers Information and Support Programme (CrISP)

The CrISP programme, provided by Alzheimer's Society, has refined its support to people affected by Dementia. CrISP seeks to provide carers with a range of information about practical and statutory supports, and advice on how to stay well while addressing the challenges of living with dementia and being a carer.

The programme is hugely beneficial, particularly for planning for the future. Carers have said: "The course was really helpful for me and was presented in a warm, caring and clear and informative way with professionalism. The content of the course all felt very relevant and has given me confidence."

The programme is now delivered over two sessions, and it is offered as a face to face programme or there are two online opportunities.

The Belfast programme is available to carers of anyone with a dementia diagnosis in the Belfast Trust area. Alzheimer's Society has said that people who are referred in to the programme and complete a referral form have a better and more useful experience of the CrISP Programme.
