# **East Belfast Dementia Info Day**

Following the success of the Belfast Dementia Info Day, East Belfast is presenting its own session for local people affected by dementia.

The East Belfast Dementia Info Day is on Thursday 19th September 2024 between 10.30-1.30pm at Willowfield Church Hall, (on the opposite side of the road to Willowfeld Church) Woodstock Road, Belfast.

The info day seeks to help people affected by Dementia in East Belfast, and carers, learn about all of the supports available in the local area, and also enjoy a few treats.

This is a dementia friendly event, and people living with Dementia and their carers can talk to a range of organisations about support. Organisations attending include Alzheimer's Society, Engage with Age, East Belfast Community Development Agency, Libraries NI, and service providers like Sydenham Court supported housing.

Belfast Trust's Dementia Navigators will be there providing information. Although it will not be possible for any staff to provide medical or clinical advice, the navigators will be able to link service users into to a wide range of supports and provide information about statutory support you may not be aware of.

In addition to information, people attending will be able to enjoy some arts and crafts activities, and there will be relaxation and personal care treats. Refreshments will be available on the day.



There is a huge range of support for people living with dementia, as the inside of this month's guide shows. Join us on Thursday 19th September 2024 between 10.30-1.30pm.

## **Presence in the Past**

From August right through to October, Engage with Age is exhibiting it's "Presence in the Past" art exhibition at venues throughout Belfast.

"Presence in the Past" is the latest display of art works created by Engage with Age's Dementia Friendly Artist in Residence programme, funded by the Arts Council of Northern Ireland and the Baring Foundation.

Since January this year, artist Anna O'Kane has been working with people in five dementia support centres across Belfast undertaking art and crafting workshops. Over 50 workshops have taken place.

Anna facilitates art sessions in which people living with dementia talk about their interests and memories, and produce art works based on their experiences, their likes and their dislikes. A range of art mediums is used including paint, felting, collage, and work with pen and ink. During the art workshops participants share memories and stories about their lives.

The participating centres include Edgecumbe Day Centre, Sydenham Court, and Kirk House in East Belfast, and Mount Oriel Day Centre and City Way Day Centre in South Belfast.

The works have been gathered together in an exhibition that will be shown throughout Belfast. In August the exhibition will be at Newtownbreda Library between the 5th - 17th August, and the Skainos Centre between 19th - 30th August. Future venues include Tullycarnet

Library, and it will be at 2 Royal Avenue between 1st - 15th October as part of Positive Ageing Month.
