October is Positive Ageing Month. This month long festival of events for older people is a celebration of everything that is best about enjoying later life in Belfast.

The Belfast City Council Age Friendly team has put together an eclectic programme of health events, information on opportunities for older people, events to stimulate our creativity, to keep us active, and for us to enjoy.

A number of events have a particular focus on health and wellbeing. These include health events at Girdwood Community Hub and Finaghy Community Centre, sessions on moving more to live more, and "Active Ageing Games" to keep us sprightly and have fun.

There is a terrific range of film screenings including "Calamity Jane" and "Arsenic and Old Lace" in Belfast City Hall. For anyone who enjoys a dance, there are Tea Dances and Halloween Tea Dances Knocknagoney Community Centre, Ligoniel Community Centre, and Girdwood Community Hub. Online Interactive Dementia Training

Dementia Friendly East Belfast's Online Interactive Dementia Training is back at 7pm on Wednesday 9th October 2024.

The training was developed in 2021 as a way of coping with the restrictions of the need to stay at home for the Covid Pandemic. What was created is a fantastic series of training videos by experts covering a range of topics, presented in an interactive fashion using Zoom.

Learn how to make your home, managing money, going shopping and getting out and about more dementia friendly, from the comfort of your own home. Training participants get sent a Zoom link and spend the session sharing experiences, having questions answered, and watch specially made videos packed with low cost/ no cost top tips to make life more dementia friendly. The training comes highly recommended by previous participants who have said:

The session is suitable for family members, carers and friends, and anyone who delivers a service such as running a centre or a shop. The session lasts 2 hours with a comfort break midway.
