Dementia Friendly Artist in Residence

Engage with Age's Dementia Friendly Artist in Residence scheme has spread into North and West Belfast to help empower the creativity of people living with dementia in that part of the city.

The artist in residence programme is delivered by artist Anna O'Kane, who has been specialising in dementia friendly work with Engage with Age since 2015. Anna's method is to enable participants with mild to moderate dementia to make images and enjoy being creative using a range of art materials. Anna's methods emphasise good clear communication, a simple creative environment, and a working at an appropriate pace with participants.

Workshops take place with groups of five or six people, who participate over a ten week period on making works based on the memories, interests and the suggestions of the participants. Anna works to empower each participant to make art and experience the enjoyment of creativity.

This new programme is working at Hemsworth Court and Newington Day Centre, Cullingtree Meadows and Ballyowen Day Centre.

The work produced by the art workshops will result in an art exhibition which will be displayed in North and West Belfast and also Belfast City Centre.

Alongside art workshops, there is a series of art training sessions for family members, carers, and health staff.

Everyone will learn techniques that can be used to make sure people living with dementia enjoy creativity, and much of the training is transferrable to other situations.

The North and West Belfast programme has been made possible from generous support from the LFT Charitable Trust. Engage with Age's programme in East and South Belfast will commence later in this year thanks to support from the Arts Council of Northern Ireland's Arts and Older People Programme.


Dementia Friendly Church

Staying in contact with your community is an important way of getting support for people living with dementia and their carers. Church congregations are an important part of many people's lives.

A number of churches have had dementia friendly initiatives to make it easier for people with dementia to participate in their communities.

On the last Friday of every month, Fitzroy Presbyterian Church holds a "Memory Lane" church service. This is a 30 minute service with hymns and prayer and an opportunity for reflection. There is no need to book, and all are welcome to attend. The service is followed by tea and coffee for a chance to socialise.

Churches are very welcoming for people living with dementia and are important hubs for community contact. If you are seeking ways to retain connections with your congregation contact clergy in your local area on ways to make attending church more accessible for you.
